Members must be United States citizens and residents of La Mirada. Other requirements may apply to specific Commissions/Councils or the Foundation. Terms of office range from one year, two years or four years, depending on the advisory body.

All persons appointed are required to take an oath of office and sign the City's Code of Ethical Conduct. Members are also required to comply with the City's attendance and dress code policies.
